



Your classroom. Your AI rules. Enforced.

Tenet sits in the student's browser. You write the rules for your class in plain English. The AI follows them. When students try to wander off to AI tools you didn't approve, Tenet blocks them.

WHAT TENET IS

An AI governance platform your district deploys to every student device through the Google Admin Console. Open the Tenet dashboard, find your classes, and write your AI guardrails in plain English. Those guardrails are established for every student conversation with the AI platforms you allow (ChatGPT, Claude, Gemini, Copilot, Grok, MagicSchool, SchoolAI) before the conversation begins. Bell-schedule aware: your rules apply automatically during your period and stand down when it ends.

EXAMPLE: RULES YOU MIGHT WRITE

10TH-GRADE ENGLISH · MR. PATEL

Shakespeare day

" We are only learning about Shakespeare today. Be Socratic: ask the student a guiding question before giving any answer, so they do the thinking. Reply ONLY in iambic pentameter. If the student asks about anything outside Shakespeare or English literature, politely redirect them back to today's topic in verse. Do not write full essays or sonnets for the student. "

Allowed in this class: ChatGPT, Claude

SPANISH III · SRA. GARCIA

Immersion mode

" Solo en español. Respond only in Spanish, even if the student writes in English. Be Socratic: ask guiding questions in Spanish before giving any answer. If they write in English, ask them in Spanish to try the question again. Never give full translations of sentences. Push them to figure out vocabulary from context, then confirm or correct. "

WE CATCH AI USE YOU DIDN'T APPROVE

Tenet doesn't just shape the AI conversations you DID approve. It also **detects and blocks unapproved AI use of any kind**: a student opening an AI tool you didn't allow for your class, a chatbot embedded inside a homework helper, an attempt to switch to a different model to dodge your rule, or pasted content from an unapproved AI dropped into your approved tool. Tenet catches it and the student sees a polite redirect to the platforms you did approve.

A FEW MORE THINGS YOU'LL USE WEEKLY

Test Drive your class

One click to preview your rules from a student's seat. Try a few prompts. Catch surprises before your students do.

Block All AI mode

For test days: one toggle, no AI on any platform during your period. Auto-reverts when your period ends.

Take-home rules

Different guidance for the same class when students are at home. AI helps them study, but locked exam content stays blocked.

Weekly incident view

A five-minute scan shows what was blocked, who tried what, and which students might need a quick check-in.

Tenet also scrubs student personal information out of prompts automatically before they reach the AI vendor. You don't have to think about it.
